Position Title: Interpretation Volunteer

Brief Description of the Position: Volunteers will be responsible for facilitating communication for people with limited English proficiency. Our center is currently looking for individuals who are fluent in Ukrainian, Swahili, Chinese, Tigrinya and Somali. In order to effectively provide services and programs to newcomers from different cultural backgrounds, we require language support for both clients and staff. The timings are quite flexible, as it is a needs-based support. All volunteers will be given at least a two week's notice when volunteer opportunities are available.

Major Duties:

- Arrive on time, and prepared for the day
- Accurately interpret conversations between clients and staff
- Assist staff with any activity/program when required
- Provide a safe environment for participants
- Communicate with other staff and volunteers
- Maintain confidentiality
